## **1. The Event**

The event is a Rover Scout Motorsport event and is open to club members and associate members only. It is a non speed event and will consist of a series of Khanacross and Motorkhana activities. The CAMS Event Permit number is:

## **5. Authority**

The event will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS), the Khanacross Regulations, the National Motorkhana Code, the Rover Scout Motorsport Standing Regulations, the event supplementary regulations and any further regulations that may be issued.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)

## **6. Place and Date**

The event will be conducted at Walky Park, corner of Old Railway Rd and Mt. Mary Rd, Stonefield from Friday 2nd October 2009 at 4pm until Monday 5th of October 2009 at 1pm with competition occurring between Saturday 3rd October 2009 at 9:30 until Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2009 at 9pm.

## **7. Entries**

- a. Entries will be open from the publication of these regulations until 9:00am, Saturday October 3rd, 2009
- b. Entries will only be accepted by persons who are financial members of Rover Scout Motorsport
- c. Temporary Membership is available to teams not covered by CAMS affiliated clubs however they must be financial members of the Scout Association of Australia.
- d. The entry cost will be \$10 per driver / navigator
- e. The maximum number of entries will be 25 vehicles
- f. Cheques are to "The Scout Association of Australia (SA Branch) – Sandblast"
- g. Entry forms are to be completed in full, including signatures and must be accompanied with the full payment and returned to the event secretary prior to the closing date.
- h. The promoter reserves the right to refuse entry to the event at their own discretion in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

## **8. Insurance**

- a. Public risk insurance has been effected by the promoters through CAMS.
- b. All competitors, drivers and signed on officials are covered by the motor sport personal accident policy
- c. For further details refer to Appendix I of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motorsport.

## **9. Classes**

- Class 1: Rovers (A rover team with a minimum of 3 drivers. One "Old Boy" / RA allowed)
- Class 2: Venturers (A venturer team with a minimum of 3 drivers. One Rover / leader allowed)
- Class 3: Open (No minimum drivers. Team may include Rovers, Venturers, "Old Boys" or mixed)

## **10. Starting Order**

Starting order for each test will be notified in writing at the drivers briefing.

## **11. Crew Members**

- a. All competitors, drivers and crew members that are participating in the competition must fall under Rover Motorsport Regulation section B, 1.3.
- b. Exactly two persons must be in the vehicle while competing
- c. Any competitor under the age of 18 in a vehicle driven by anyone without a FULL Drivers license from any Australian State must have written permission from their parent or guardian. (Scout Y4 Form)
- d. Competing crew must wear neck braces while competing and be wearing helmets to AS1698 standards as well as Goggles to AS1609 standards (CAMS Manual) Schedule D Apparel, 3(iv), 3(vi)

## **12. Crew Briefing**

- a. It is compulsory for all drivers and navigators to attend the applicable driver briefing for their discipline. Any driver who misses their briefing will be ineligible to drive for the applicable discipline.
- b. All briefings will be conducted in the main marquee 30 minutes prior to all morning disciplines and 30 minutes prior to all afternoon disciplines.

## **13. Vehicle Eligibility**

- a. This event is only open to RSMSA, Section D vehicles only.

## **14. Scrutineering**

- a. Scrutineering will take place at the venue and will commence on Friday October 2<sup>nd</sup> between the hours of 7:00pm and 10:00pm
- b. Scrutineering will recommence on Saturday October 3<sup>rd</sup> between the hours of 7:00am and 9:00am
- c. All competing vehicles must be presented and pass pre-event scrutineering prior to competing in any competition
- d. CAMS licenses (Minimum Level 2 Non Speed) must be presented before scrutineering commences to the secretary at the same time the event entry fee is paid
- e. Proof of Club Membership must be presented before scrutineering commences to the secretary at the same time the event entry fee is paid
- f. Vehicles may attend a pre-vehicle inspection day to be arranged with the chief scrutineer.

## **15. Pit Area**

- a. Entry to the pit area is restricted to properly credentialed crew members and officials.
- b. Vehicles entering or leaving the pit area are to travel at walking pace and must follow directional markers.
- c. Vehicles may only leave the pit area to compete or with the permission of the Clerk of Course
- d. Crews are allowed one vehicle and one trailer in the pit area. This vehicle is not allowed to leave the pit area without the express permission of the Clerk of course. Any vehicle left on site without an official permit may be towed.

## **16. Alcohol**

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

### ***Other Prohibited Substances***

The CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the Drugs in Sport Policy conflict, the Drugs in Sport Policy will take precedence.

## **17. Competition and Layout**

- a. The competition will be conducted as per the schedule produced in the Sandblast Program
- b. The first test will commence at 9:30am on Saturday morning.
- c. The competition tracks will be laid out to conform to Motorkhana and Khanacross regulations.
- d. Each test will be given its own identity
- e. There will be a minimum of 4 tests and a maximum of 6
- g. Time penalties will apply for missing or hitting obstacles in accordance with the drivers briefing and breaking rules of the test.
- h. Scoring will be based on individual times. The lowest overall time being the winner.
- i. The program of events will be issued before Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2009.
- j. Each team must supply a minimum of 2 general marshals.
- k. Each test is open to multiple competitors from each team subject to available time.
- l. On completion of each test, each team must nominate a drivers score to that test.
- m. **All** drivers in a team must have nominated a time before any driver is eligible to nominate a time for another test.

## **18. Awards**

- a. Trophies will be awarded in the Rover Class: 1<sup>st</sup>
- b. Trophies will be awarded in the Venturer Class: 1<sup>st</sup>
- c. Trophies will be awarded in the Open Class: 1<sup>st</sup>
- d. Additional trophies may be awarded for individual tests.

## **19. Protests**

- a. Only the competitor may protest. The competitor is the crew leader listed on the entry form.
- b. Protests may be made under Part XII of the CAMS Manual of Motorsport.
- c. Protestors may not be under the influence of any substance that may affect judgement.
- d. Event Command Staff can decide if a line of query or complaint shall be deemed as a protest to ensure it is handled appropriately as per the CAMS National Competition rules.

## **20. Abandonment**

a. The promoter reserves the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the meeting at their own discretion in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.
